# Numbers add up for Spartans

Madison Memorial prep girls swimming coach Jason Verhelst has discovered a dynamic about his team that he is starting to like. And that dynamic played its biggest role Friday night.

"Our depth is amazing," Verhelst said. "If you look at the boxscore from this meet, because Middleton won a lot of races, you would think that they won the meet. But sometimes it's consistency and not winning individual races that's most important."

Consistency once again won out, as the host Spartans rolled past Middleton 101-69 to essentially wrap up the Big Eight Middleton won five individual events and two relays, but the Cardinals were never a threat

the Big Eight," said Verhelst, who got 11 second-place and seven third-place finishes from his team to go along with four wins. "The next step is to win (the conference title)."

Memorial (6-0 Big Eight) certainly looks like it has the tools to do that, led by sophomore Kayla Smith. Smith won the 50-yard freestyle in :24.66 seconds, and then won the 100 freestyle in :54.54 as the Spartans jumped out to a 35-27 lead.

"We knew this meet was going to be a big one for us," Smith said. "They beat us by two points last year and we talked this week about how it would take the entire team to beat them.
